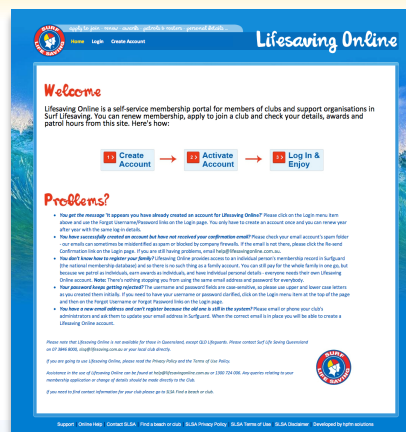




By signing up for Lifesaving Online, you can apply to join a surf life saving club and an existing member can ensure that all their personal information, as stored in the SLSA member database (SurfGuard), is correct.

In addition to handling membership requests and renewals, Lifesaving Online also gives access to all awards, patrols, memberships and personal details associated with a member record. The website seamlessly connects with SLSA's own payment gateway (pay.slsa.com.au) meaning you can apply for and pay to join a club completely electronically.

The beauty of Lifesaving Online is that it gives members of surf life saving clubs instant access to all of their own personal club-related information. In the past, a club member would need to have asked a club official with SurfGuard access to retrieve this information.

If you need to know when your Bronze Medallion's proficiency is due, when you're next on patrol or simply change the mobile phone number you have listed you can log on at any time, access your data and make any changes you require.

**MY AWARDS**

Lifesaving Online taps directly into SLSA's SurfGuard database and enables you to view all your awards, along with the date you gained them, their expiry date, their proficiency expiry date (if they have one) and the organisation you gained that qualification with.

This great feature enables you to plan further awards and prepare effectively for re-qualification.

**MY PATROLS**

If you are an active patrol member in an SLSA club and if your club captain has logged all the patrol rosters onto SurfGuard (the national membership database), then you will be able to view the dates of forthcoming patrols in this section of the site. Furthermore, if you patrol for more than one club then you'll be able to see those patrols too.

You can view your patrols by calendar date, by organisation (if you are a member at more than one club) or by patrol team. You can also click on a specific date on the mini-calendar to see any patrols you have on that particular date.
