SCOPE

To give members the opportunity, within a safe environment, to maintain a competent level of swimming ability to fulfil patrolling obligations.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of this policy are to outline who is eligible to participate in Club Swimming Training.

SPECIFICATIONS

Noosa Heads SLSC provides free swimming training to members who meet the requirements within this policy.

The Swimming training is provided at the Good Shepherd Lutheran College Pool - 115 Eumundi Rd Noosaville - 6pm to 7pm on Monday and Thursday or as varied by the Management Committee.

ELIGIBILITY

This policy applies to financial proficient members on the current patrol roster, who hold one of the following membership categories: Active Senior, Long Service, Life members, Reserve Active, Active Junior holding a Bronze Medallion Award.

Active Cadets and Nippers who patrol are permitted to attend with the approval of the Junior Activities Coaching Director.

Members who are registered on a Bronze Medallion course can attend with the approval of Education Manager.

PROCEDURE

Active Cadet - Nipper

- 1. Contact Junior Activities Coach to discuss eligibility to attend Club swimming training.
- 2. Written approval must be sent to Administration from Junior Activities Coaching Coordinator and must be received prior to attending.

Pool

- 1. Arrive at Pool 15 minutes prior to start time.
- 2. Register and sign attendance sheet.
