OUR PROGRAM

Nippers was established at the Noosa Heads Surf Lifesaving Club in 1967. With 52 years experience we have grown to be the largest nippers program in Queensland. The program runs across both Noosa Heads and Peregian Beach. This gives families the flexibility of two different beach conditions. Peregian Beach has a small welcoming community. Peregian's program is in its inaugural season and is continuing to flourish. Noosa Heads provides more sheltered conditions and an awesome competitive edge. Both locations have the same program, family-friendly environment and value for money.

The nipper program is designed to introduce children aged 5 to 14 to Surf Lifesaving. It is a fun outdoor activity that grows a child's confidence and teaches valuable surf awareness skills. Our aim is to provide a safe, family-friendly and fun environment for our Nippers. Kids living on the coast should be equipped with the best skills and knowledge for safe us of Australian beaches. MEMBERSHIP & AGE CATEGORIES

Noosa Heads SLSC membership year is from 1st July through to 30th June each year. Renewal applications will normally be forwarded during June. Membership includes insurance and affiliation with both SLSQ and SLSA.

Membership applications are to be completed on the Members Portal (website https://portal.sls.com.au). All applications must be approved by the Management Committee and fees must be paid prior to participation in any club activities including training and courses. Be sure to update any changes of your details, including your driver's license and blue card details.

Three Easy Steps to Renew your Membership

This whole process can be done on your computer at home or even while you're waiting for the school pick up. Just follow these three easy steps. Please note that all memberships will end on the 30th of June.

1. MEMBER'S PORTAL

To renew your membership, it is all done through the members portal. Head to the *membership* tab and select the **FAMILY** drop down and select renew membership for your *family group* (see step 3 if you don't have a family group) at this stage you can also update details. Don't forget to SUMBIT. Follow the link to head to the members portal https://members.sls.com.au/SLSA Online/modules/login/index.php

2. MAKE A PAYMENT

Once you have renewed all members of the family and updated any contact details than you are ready to pay. After you have paid for the membership your membership will be processed by the club. This can take up to 2-3 business days. We will be in contact with you if there are any missing steps

3. CREATING A FAMILY GROUP

Once signed into your members portal click the *Membership* tab and select the *Family* drop down. You will see the *create a family group* icon on the right-hand side of the page. Once you are in, add your family by

searching their name and selecting the *top arrow* in between the two boxes. You will sometimes need to search for them one at a time. If you have any issues with this step, please do not hesitate to contact us in the office. Don't forget to hit SUMBIT when you're done.

Applying as a NEW Member

1. Joining Form

All our memberships are processed online to make it easier for you. Head to https://sls.com.au/join/ to get started. All family members that will be participating INCLUDING AT LEAST ONE PARENT will need to fill the entire from.

2. Payment

Once your have completed your form you will need to pay for your year of membership. Alternatively you can pay at our office during business hours, including over the phone.

Nipper Family Membership Fees

3. Creating a Members Portal

The members portal is our database for all of your contact and personal details. This is where you will need to renew your membership next season and keep your contacts up to date. Head to https://members.sls.com.au/SLSA Online/modules/login/index.php and select the click here inside the yellow box. This will set up your account, make sure you use a well know password as this is not often used but is very important.

4. Team App

We use team app to communicate all of our upcoming events, training schedules, and even to keep in contact with your age manager. Simple download the TEAM APP app in the apple or play stores and search Noosa Heads Nippers, request to join and we will accept within 2 -3 working days.

Age Categories

Surf Life Saving Queensland has deemed that all nippers are to participate in the program in their designated age groups. We are unable to change age groups for any nipper. The cut off for nipper age groups is the 30th of September.

SWIMMING COMPETENCIES & EVALUATIONS

ALL nippers MUST complete a pool swimming evaluation to participate in the program. In order to swim attend at Nippers Training and Nipper Sundays, nippers must also complete a run-swim-run evaluation. If the nipper wishes to compete at surf sports events, they will need to complete a second run-swim-run directly following the first. Please refer to the chart below for competency and evaluation standards.

NIPPER SUNDAYS

SIGN IN/OUT

On arrival at the club parents MUST complete the sign on sheet to register their children for the session. Nippers must be signed in EVERY Nipper Sunday. If you do not sign on and sign off your Nipper's attendance will not be counted. This may affect your eligibility for subsidies. Parents MUST be in attendance for the entirety of the program for emergency reasons. Nippers without parents in attendance will be sat out of activities. Sign out must be completed before leaving the beach. If you do not sign out, you will be contacted regarding the whereabouts of your child. If you need to sign out early, please ensure to sign out with your Parent Liaison.

SESSION TIMES

U6 - U7: 7.45am — 9.15am U8 - U14: 7.45am — 10.00am

UNIFORM

Nippers must always wear their coloured nipper cap and pink hi-vis singlet during the session. Club togs are optional on a Nipper Sunday; however they are compulsory if nippers wish to compete.

INJURIES

Any injuries sustained either at training or nipper Sundays need to be reported to the age manager or coach immediately.

It is the Parent's obligation to immediately notify SLSA in writing through your Club's Administration of any change to medical conditions, fitness and ability to participate. Members under 14 years are unable to be covered by Workcover, therefore they are covered by our Public Liability Insurance. The same limitations apply as above.

NIPPERS SURF SPORTS TRAINING

Surf Sports training is held during the week and is optional to attend. We have a crew of professional coaches who develop our nippers' techniques in the water and on the beach. Training schedules are released fortnightly and will be send via email. All equipment is provided. Usual uniform is required. If you do not have your pink rashie or coloured cap you will not be able to participate.

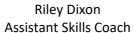
Mitch Hunter

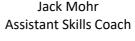
Mitch's interest is in Beach Sprints and he plans on developing the Noosa Nippers into a force to be reckoned with on the sand.

SURF SPORTS CARNIVALS

Our nippers program includes competing in surf sports carnivals. Please note nippers will have to pass an evaluation in order to compete as stated in 'Swimming Competencies & Evaluations'. Surf Sport Carnivals are held over 1- 2 days, there are usually 2-4 carnival for each age group. These carnivals are against other Sunshine Coast regional clubs and take place between Rainbow Beach and Redcliffe Beach (refer to calendar for this season carnival dates and locations). Entry forms will be sent via email and via Team App. Please note closing dates are strict and not flexible. Entry fees will apply if the competitor is entered and does not show.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS

Members and all people involved in any way with SLS will:

- a) Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others—treat others as you would like to be treated yourself

- c) Be professional in, and accept responsibility for your actions

- e) Operate within the rules and spirit of the sport, including the national and international guidelines that govern SLS
- f) Understand the possible consequences of breaching the codes and/or this policy
- g) Report any breaches of the codes or this policy to the appropriate PPA
- h) Refrain from any form of abuse, harassment, discrimination and victimisation towards others
- i) Raise concerns regarding decisions of PPA through the appropriate channels and in a timely manner

- j) Provide a safe environment for the conduct of activities in accordance with any relevant SLSA policy
- k) Show concern, empathy and caution towards others that may be sick or injured
- I) Be a positive role model to all
- m) Respect and protect confidential information obtained through SLS activities or services; whether individuals and/or organisational information
- n) Maintain the required standard of accreditation and/or licensing of professional competencies, as applicable to the role(s)
- o) Ensure that any physical contact with others is appropriate to the situation and necessary for the person's skill development
- p) Refrain from intimate relations with persons over whom you have a position of authority
- q) Agree to abide by the codes
- r) Maintain a duty of care towards others
- s) Be impartial and accept the responsibility for all actions taken

Person in Position of Authority (PPA):

PPA include everyone who holds a position of authority in SLS, whether paid or unpaid, and includes, but is not limited to, all SLS Entity Individual Members. For the avoidance of doubt, PPA also includes Child or Young Person (CYP) who may hold a position of authority in SLS over other CYP.
