## NOOSA HEADS SLSC POLICY

### COMPETITION RIGHTS ONLY TRANSFERS – IN & OUT

#### **SCOPE**

This Policy applies to all Active and Competing Members of Noosa Heads Surf Life Saving Club who wish to transfer their Competition Rights to another Club. This Policy also applies to Members of other Clubs wishing to transfer their Competition Rights to Noosa Heads SLSC.

#### **OBJECTIVE**

This Policy is to define the circumstances under which a Competition Rights only transfer into or out of Noosa Heads SLSC will be considered by the Board. This Policy also defines the procedures to be followed by Members wishing to apply for Competition Rights only transfers into or out of Noosa Heads SLSC (NHSLSC).

#### **SECTION 1 - SPECIFICATIONS – CIRCUMSTANCES ELIGIBLE FOR CONSIDERATION**

1. NHSLSC's usual policy regarding transfers in or out is that the Member must apply for a Full Transfer, i.e., transfer of all rights and obligations, including patrolling obligations, into the receiving Club.
2. Competition Rights only transfers will only be considered for specific events or specific series of events, on a temporary basis, and where the opportunity to train or compete in those events does not exist at the Member's current Club.
3. This policy is primarily intended to allow participation in one-off single day events but may be applied to a series of events over a short time period. If a series of events is held over an extended period of time, the Member may be required to apply for a Full Transfer.
4. The Member must continue to fulfill their other obligations (e.g., patrolling), at their current Club. If those obligations cannot be fulfilled, the Member may be required to apply for a Full Transfer. This is to avoid clashes of obligations at both Clubs, and to maintain an offer of goodwill to the Member on the understanding that the Transfer is on a temporary basis only.
5. The Member must transfer back to the original Club within two weeks of the completion of the event or series of events.
6. Competition Rights only Transfers In will only be considered for endorsement by the NHSLSC Board if the losing Club has also previously endorsed the Transfer.

## SECTION 2 – PROCEDURE

1. The Member shall discuss the desire for a temporary Competition Rights only Transfer with the relevant personnel at both Clubs as far as practicable, i.e. Head Coach, Director of Surf Sports, etc. The Member shall be provided with a copy of this Policy when discussing with NHSLSC personnel.
2. The Member shall provide a signed copy of this Policy to NHSLSC to acknowledge their understanding of this Policy and to accept the condition to continue to fulfill other obligations with their current Club, and to accept the condition to Transfer back at the completion of the event(s).
3. Where possible the relevant NHSLSC Director shall discuss the transfer with the other Club to ensure that both Clubs are in agreeance or otherwise, and to ensure both Clubs are aware of the circumstances and the time period that the transfer is to take effect. The other Club shall be provided a copy of this policy for their records.
4. The Member shall apply for the Transfer through the usual SLSA Member’s Portal.
5. The Losing Club shall endorse (or otherwise) the Transfer and communicate the decision to the Winning (Receiving) Club. The Winning Club shall then endorse (or otherwise) the Transfer in the usual manner. This step is important to avoid the situation where one Club endorses the application, but the other Club rejects it. This is also important for maintaining good inter-Club relations.
6. The Member shall participate in training and in the event or series of events at the direction of the Head Coach and Discipline Coach.
7. At the completion of the event or series of events, the Member shall complete a Transfer back to their original Club within two weeks of the completion of the event(s). Both Clubs should be aware of this requirement from discussions prior to the original Transfer.
